“I don’t have to rely on anybody to really help me, and I am more motivated and keener to do all my work”, Bella-Rosa said.

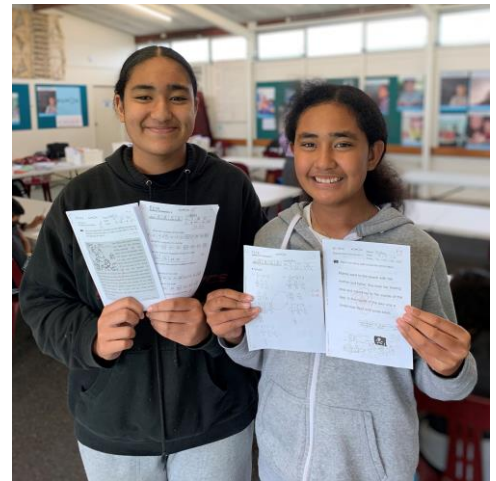

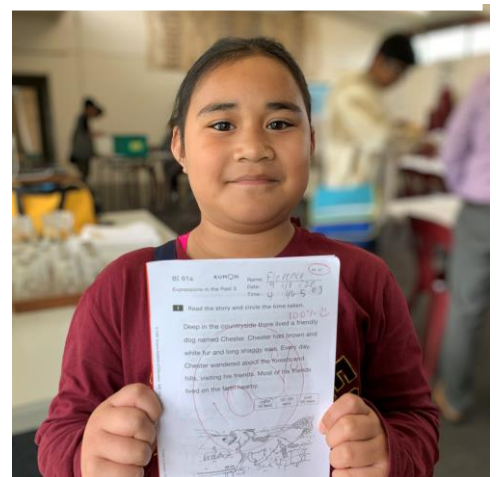

Florence, a Kumon Mathematics and English student.

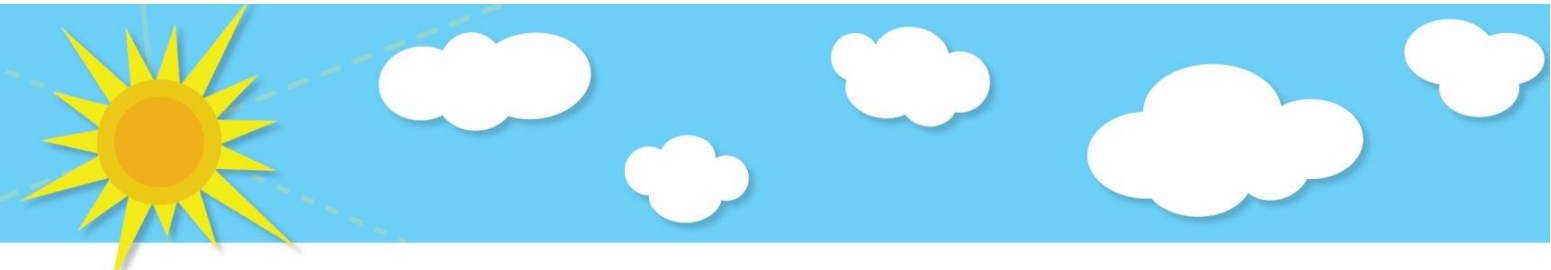
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We thank all of our Kumon families for your wonderful support as we navigated this challenging year together.
